- The above following question has to be answered as the following based on CQUIN
- CQUIN states 80% of confectionary must be under 250Kal
- Large Combination machines stock 92.3% under 250kal
- Large Snack Machines stock 80% under this 250kal
- Drinks Machines all zero rated 100%
- Standard Combination machines / Drinks all zero rated 100% / Snacks 80% under 250kal
- Standard machine snack 87% of offer under 250kal
- 3. How much profit did the trust earn from these machines in each of the past five years? If possible, could you separate that figure for the separate types of vending machines please.
